Additional references on some of the symbols of Revelation.

1. The woman = a church. (Jer. 3:20; Eze. 23:2-4; Jer. 6:2; Isa. 54:5-6). A pure woman (Rev. 12) represents a church that is faithfully teaching God's word only and not man-made doctrines). An unfaithful woman

(Rev. 17) = a church that is teaching God's word and manmade doctrines.

- 2. The dragon = Satan (Rev. 12:9).
- 3. The woman standing on the moon (Rev. 12) represents God's faithful people from the birth of Jesus until the end of time.
- a. Rev. 12:4-5 Satan tries to destroy Jesus (Isa. 11:4; Rev. 2:27; 19:5; Mt. 2:16)
- C. How does this apply to us today?
- 1. God has a complete plan of salvation that will not just provide for people in the past, but will take us all the way home until he returns (Mt. 28:20; Heb. 13:5).
- 2. Part of Go's provision for us is to give us the prophecies, so we can know what is coming and how to prepare, so we can be ready for His

return.

3. Elijah prayed on Mt. Carmel for fire from heaven to burn up the sacrifice on the altar, and it burned up the sacrifice, the rocks, and the water in the trench. If we are going to participate in sharing the Elijah message we will need His spirit. I pray that He will send that fire to burn in us this week, so we might influence others to worship Him and be prepared for His return.
