## **Daniel's Life**

Script - Heb. 11:27; Rom. 8:18; Prov. 13:12; Heb. 11:30-40; 2 Cor. 4:16-18

Sub - Hope

Theme - Hope gives encouragement

Prop - We can have hope under stress if we keep our eyes on the reward beyond the present focused on God and his promised

Introduction - Review of the "Not Half-way Home Series"

- 1. Basic concept A story and a prophecy then a prophetic fulfillment.
  - a. Nehemiah, the prophetic fulfillment.
  - b. Elijah two prophetic fulfillments.
- A. What did he face? Daniel had a difficult life.
  - 1. Daniel taken captive at a young age.
    - a. Probably parents slain.
  - b. Separated from relatives and family.
    - c. Taken to a foreign land (Babylon) (Dan. 1:1).
    - d. His name was changed. (Dan. 1:6-7; 4:8).
    - e. He wis made a eunuch in Neb court. No future of his own. No wife. No kids (Isa. 39:1-7).

## B. How did he cope?

- 1. He stands up for what he believes (Dan. 1:8; Prov. 22:6)
- 2. Daniel negotiates a deal with Ashpenaz to eat what he believes will help him be blessed (Dan. 1:8-16; Prov. 18:24).
- 3. In. Dan. 2 he faces his 1<sup>st</sup> death decree. Daniel is at a disadvantage as he is not among those that are called to hear the king's dream but only learns about it when they started killing the wise men (Dan. 2:12-16). Again Daniel negotiates a deal with the Captain of the king's guard to be taken in to the king and requests time to pray.
- 4. In Dan. 3 Daniel's friends refuse to bow to the golden image that the king erected. Did Daniel influence his friends to not bow down even though Daniel was not present.
- 5. In. Dan. 6 Daniel is willing to pray, even on pain of death in the lion's den.

## C. What can we learn?

- 1. Daniel's life gives us hope that it is possible to overcome all the stressful challenges of life when we trust in God and his word.
- 2. Daniel illustrates the importance of staying connected with God through prayer.
- 3. Daniel's relationship with his friends shows the importance of our youth choosing wisely.
- 4. Daniel's life illustrates how valuable it is to train our children to pray and trust in God.
