     c. Ending date 1844


#### D. The judgment hour message: Revelation 14:6-7

- 1. The great white throne judgment scene: Rev. 20:12-13
- 2. Our High priest in the heavens: Heb. 8:4-5; 4:14

#### E. Other details of Daniel 8 & 9

- Time "cut off" for or set aside the Jews: Dan. 9:24
   70 weeks = 490 days (or years) for the Jews (from 457 B.C. to 34 A.D.). At the end of the 70 weeks (490 days or years) the gospel went to the Gentiles (34 A.D.): Acts 13:46
- Anointing of the Messiah: Dan. 9:25
   Jesus was anointed by the Holy Spirit at His baptism in 27 A.D. Jn. 1:32; Mk. 1:9-11
- 3. The Messiah shall be cut off in the midst of the 70th week: **Dan. 9:26-27** Jesus was "cut off" or crucified in 31 A.D. **Mt. 27:51**
- 4. He shall bring the sacrifice to an end in the midst of the week: **Dan. 9:27** (1315). The sacrificial system of slaying a lamb was brought to an end when Jesus died on the cross.
- 5. Where the seven years of tribulation come from The gap theory: Daniel 8:14; 9:24-27

### F. Daniel was a sealed book until "the time of the end". Daniel 12:4



## G. Rev. 10 (1810)

- 1. A little book "open" = the book of Daniel: **Rev. 10:2, 8**
- One foot on the land and one on the sea Rev. 10:2, 8 (1810) = a worldwide proclamation: Ps. 69:34; Ex. 20:4, 11.
- 3. **Rev. 10:9-11** = the sweet & bitter experience of the Millerites in 1844: Jer. 15:16; Eze. 3:1-3 "You must prophesy again..." Rev. 10:11
- H. Jesus is our High priest: Heb. 6:19-20
