- 2. Ar (Har) + Megiddo or Megiddon = mountain + an ancient city
- 3. Ar (Har) + Mo'ed = mountain + congregation: Isa. 14:13-14 (1041)

C. The historical significance of Megiddo

- 1. Solomon and his war horses: **1 Ki. 9:15** (566); **4:26** (553); **10:26** (569)
- 2. Gideon and the faithful few: Judges 6-7 (402)
 - a. God's people were victorious by faith: Judges 7:19-21 (402)
 - b. They were in the minority against insurmountable odds, yet victorious: Judges 8:10 (407)
 - c. God fought for His people: Judges 7:22 (406)

D. Elijah on Mt. Carmel: 1 Ki. 17-18 (583)

- 1. Famine for 3 1/2 years: **1 Ki. 17:1; James 5:17-18** (1779)
- 2. God provided for Elijah during that time: **1 Ki. 3-16**
- 3. Wicked king Ahab blamed Elijah for the famine: **1 Ki. 18:17-18** (585)
- 4. Showdown on Mt. Carmel between Elijah and prophets of Baal: **1 Ki. 18:19-39** (585)
- 5. Prophets of Baal slain: **1 Ki. 18:40** (587)

- 1. The whole world: **Rev. 16:14** (1917); **19:19-20** (1822)
- 2. The beast, and spiritual Babylon: Rev. 16:2, 10 (1817)
